





In its "typical" or traditional use as a mainframe channel, Fundamental Software's Serial Channel Adapter (SCA-1) operates as a mainframe channel, allowing the channel attachment of ESCON® (SCA-1) peripherals to FLEX•ES emulated CPUs.

- Standard IBM® ESCON cable, with an FSI-supplied adapter (MTRJ to ESCON, duplex)
- Direct connection to channel or via ESCON director

SCA-1 provides one channel of type CNC

## **Configuration and control**

- Configured with a subset of the FLEX\*ES configuration language
- Controlled using the FLEX\*ES console Command Line Interface (CLI) capability and a subset of the CLI control language

- All tape models work as emulated devices using files on disk. FSI FakeTape™, AWSTAPE, and OMA/2 formats are supported. FLEXCUB also supports emulation of these tape drive types using certified SCSI cartridge tape drives, including some that are mainframe-media compatible; the exception is the 3590, upon which only emulation on disk is supported

- Low-cost ESCON TN3270 control units
